


**Archival Memories** explores the connection and relationship to my unknown family members.







Frania Adamson's current practice centres around the art of cameraless photography, creating images such as Chemigrams which use key photographic mediums like paper and light, but not the camera itself.

Her work is highly experimental and her outcomes entirely abstract, aiming to evoke a sense of the sublime.






